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CERTIFICATE OF SUFFICIENCY

On March 26, 2025, Cathrine Olney, Committee member of the Committee to Recall Sheriff Poley, submitted 12 petition sections, totaling 196 petition signatures to the Jackson County Clerk & Recorder's office. Under Colorado law, the recall petition must contain at least 115 valid signatures.

C.R.S. 1-12-108(8)(c)(II.5)I, as Designated Election Official, found no errors or insufficiencies regarding the circulator affidavits.

The County Clerk of Jackson County has determined that the Recall Petition has submitted sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on a Special Election Ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file in the Jackson County Clerk & Recorder's Office and will be maintained as a public record.

C.R.S. 1-12-108(9)(a)(I) This recall petition has been verified as sufficient- no protest in writing under oath was filed in the office of the Designated Election Official (Jackson County Clerk & Recorder's office, 396 LaFever Street, Walden, CO 80480), by an eligible elector within fifteen days after the DEO has determined the sufficiency of the petition under subsection (8) (c). April 11, 2025

The incumbent has not resigned as of close business on the 5th day following the statement of sufficiency; therefore, I shall set the date for holding the Recall Election of Sheriff Poley.
